# 2017 Civilian Marksmanship Program Excellence in Competition (EIC) Pistol Matches Tournament Program

The Santa Margarita Gun Club (SMGC) on Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California in conjunction with the Civilian Marksmanship Program is proud to sponsor the following matches on Saturday, September 23, 2017:

1. <u>SPONSORING ORGANIZATION</u>: Santa Margarita Gun Club, Inc. Refer to SMGC web-site for Camp Pendleton vehicle entry requirements and detailed driving directions to the range.

 <u>PISTOL RANGE LOCATION:</u> Range 102, Range Complex, Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton, CA. Sunday Start time: Check in- 0700-0730 hours, Range Safety Brief/Squadding- 0745. Match 1 will Start at: 0800 hours, Match 2 will Start at: 0900 hours,

## 3. **<u>PISTOL RANGE FACILITIES:</u>**

Sanitary facilities at Range 102 are of the "Port-a-Potty" variety. There are no food or drink facilities. It is <u>highly recommended that you bring bottled drinks (non-alcoholic) and/or non-perishable food items</u>. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on or in the general vicinity of the firing lines, while live fire is being conducted.

## 4. **<u>RULES:</u>**

Current CMP Rules for the EIC Matches will apply.

## 5. <u>COMPETITION OPEN TO - ELIGIBILITY:</u>

These matches are open to all citizens and legal residents of the United States of America. Citizens of foreign nations may enter these matches upon proof of legal entry into the USA (validated passport and/or visa). Membership in the National Rifle Association, Civilian Marksmanship Program or California Rifle & Pistol Association is not required; however, <u>Membership in the Santa Margarita Gun Club is required.</u>

<u>Those persons who cannot legally participate in the shooting sports or who cannot enter a federal</u> <u>military reservation are not eligible to participate in this tournament.</u>

Participation **DOES NOT** and **WILL NOT** automatically authorize entrance onto MCB Camp Pendleton, CA.

To ensure authorized entry onto the base, eligible competitors must ensure you do the following:

> Possess a Department of Defense Vehicle Sticker authorizing you to enter the military instillation **OR** 

- > Pre-enter the matches desired utilizing the Electronic Entry forms on the club's web site AND
- ➤ Have in your possession the following items:
  - a. Valid Driver's License and or other picture Identification
  - b. Current Vehicle Registration
  - c. Current Proof of Vehicle Insurance
- > Complete the Electronically Advance Entry into the scheduled Matches.

#### 6. **<u>REGISTRATION FEES & TOURNAMENT FEES</u>**:

All competitors are required to be SMGC Members due to USMC range usage agreements and Insurance Restrictions. If you are not an annual SMGC member, an assessment fee is included for Daily SMGC Membership in the entry fee. Annual SMGC membership must be confirmed through possession of a valid membership card, or confirmation of participant inclusion in the official membership roster at the morning of registration. SMGC Membership is open to all Active Duty Members, Reserve Members and Retirees of the United States Armed Forces. Annual SMGC Civilian Memberships are dependent upon the number of Current Military members of the Club, according to the club's By Laws.

#### 7. ENTRIES - Electronic: ALL ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED IN ADVANCE:

Advanced Entries are the entries made BEFORE the <u>Wednesday</u> preceding the actual Match Dates. All Entries AFTER Wednesday at 3:00 P.M. (PST) are considered to be <u>LATE</u> and will be subject to <u>A \$10</u> <u>LATE FEE prior to the start of the match</u>. Individual competitor entries are <u>ALSO REQUIRED</u> to indicate their intent to participate <u>using the electronic Match Registration form</u> available at the SMGC website (<u>www.smgunclub.org</u>). Electronic Entries are necessary to ensure names are provided to the Base Security Office by the close of business on the Wednesday prior to the event.

- 8. MCB Camp Pendleton Security Regulations require the match sponsor (SMGC) notify the appropriate Base agency of Non Department of Defense (DoD) persons participation in the Match on the Wednesday preceding the Matches. <u>This notification is generated by the received match entry forms</u> and intention to enter messages. Therefore entry onto MCB Camp Pendleton may be denied to those persons who do not indicate their intent to participate or observe using the electronic Match <u>Registration form.</u> Additionally, persons who have expired driver's licenses will not be granted entry onto Camp Pendleton. Registration match forms must also be completed in their entirety.
- 9. ENTRY FEES: All individual Entries must be paid in prior to the start of the matches. All competitors are required to be SMGC Members due to USMC range usage agreements. If you are not an annual SMGC member, an assessment fee is included for Daily SMGC Membership in the entry fee. Annual SMGC membership must be confirmed through possession of a valid membership card, or confirmation of participant inclusion in the official membership roster at the morning of registration.

Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded upon request, less a \$10.00 service fee, providing cancellation is made prior to 6:00 P.M. (PST), Thursday, September 21, 2017.

- 10. <u>ENTRIES CLOSE:</u> Individual Entries close on the Wednesday prior to the respective match date(s) at 3:00 P.M. (PST).
- <u>POST ENTRIES</u>: Entries <u>RECEIVED</u> after 3:00 P.M. (PST), Wednesday prior to the respective match date(s) are considered <u>LATE Entries</u> and may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relay only. <u>LATE ENTRIES</u> will be subject to <u>\$ 10.00 LATE FEE prior to the start of the match</u>.
- 12. ENTRY LIMIT: 60 Individual Entries.
- 13. **<u>PISTOL MATCH START TIMES</u>**: Match 1 will Start at: **0800** hours, Match 2 will Start at: **0900** hours.

## 14. AWARDS:

Match Winners in the Grand Aggregate will receive the appropriate awards for their achievements in accordance with current CMP guidelines. All Awards will be presented on each day after the conclusion of firing, including Special SMGC Awards. All awards are furnished by the Santa Margarita Gun Club and the Civilian Marksmanship Program. **Leg Points** – Points are given to any non-distinguished shooters who place in the top ten percent of non- distinguished shooters, provided that the score fired by the competitor equals or exceeds the EIC Minimum Credit Score (Rule, 9.2.7). Calculations are based on rule 9.2.6. All Points are issued by the CMP.

**Minimum EIC Scores** – To receive EIC credit points, the score fired by the competitor must fulfill the requirements of Rule 9.2.6 (top 10%) and equal or exceed the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) for that discipline (see CMP Rule 9.2.7). MCS scores for 2015 are:

- Service Pistol. 250 out of 300 points

- .22 Rimfire Pistol. 260 out of 300 points

Official recognition of the overall tournament classification winners will be recorded in the Tournament Results Bulletin for the total tournament aggregate score regardless of competitor category or equipment type: Places 1, 2 and 3 for each category winner.

Official recognition of the Match Winners will be recorded in the Tournament Results Bulletin for match No. 1-10. Separate recognition will be given to by equipment type:

SMGC will also award "Special Awards" for participants of both EIC Matches. Awards will be distributed at the range or mailed to the appropriate competitors using the address information provided in the match registration form if they are not present at the time of the awards ceremony.

## 15. MATCH SCHEDULE - COURSES OF FIRE (Both EIC Matches):

**NOTE:** Results will be posted after the conclusion of firing. Awards will be given out after firing is complete for the day. Continued Pistol Marksmanship training will be held after the awards ceremony is concluded.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

## 16. CHECK-IN PROCEDURES:

All competitors must check in at the Match Statistical Office for administrative processing. *The Statistical Office* (*Range 102*) will be open from <u>0700 hours to 0730 hours</u> on Saturday Pistol EIC Tournament.

Competitors are required to complete administrative processing, ensure payment of tournament fees, and receive their squadding assignments before they can participate.

#### 17. MANDATORY RANGE SAFETY & ENVIRONMENTAL BREIFING:

After completion of administrative processing, report to the designated yard line not later than <u>0745 hours</u>. Prior to the Matches all competitors must attend the mandated range safety and environmental briefing. Competitors not attending the mandated briefing <u>will not be allowed</u> to compete. Entry fees will be refunded less a \$10.00 processing charge.

- 18. **TARGETS:** Official NRA Targets B-6 and B-8 will be used in the pistol competitions.
- 19. <u>COMPETITOR PARKING AREAS:</u> (*Range 102*) Competitor parking is permitted in the designated dirt parking lot behind the Pistol Range. ALL Competitors are required to park their vehicles in this parking lot to the rear of the range.
- 20. <u>SAFETY EQUIPMENT</u>: Hearing Protection, Eye Protection, and Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI) are <u>mandatory</u>. ECI's may be purchased at the range for a cost of \$1.00.
- 21. <u>AMMUNITION</u>: Competitors must supply their own ammunition. Any safe center-fire ammunition, up to and including .45 ACP may be used. **Tracer, incendiary or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited** (Rule 3.17(b) applies).
- 22. <u>SIGHTING SHOTS</u>: Sighting shots are not allowed for either match.
- 23. <u>SCORING SHOTS</u>: Competitor will score each other's targets. Competitors will score the shooters shots and place the value of the shot on the other Competitor's score card. Challenges will be addressed and confirmed by the competitors at the time of scoring.
- 24. <u>CHALLENGES</u>: A fee of \$2.00 is required and payable upon requesting the challenge. If the challenge is denied, the fee will be forfeit.
- 25. <u>CHALLENGE PERIOD</u>: The challenge period will end ½ hour after the posting of the last match results.
- 26. **<u>RULES</u>**: Current Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Rules will apply.

- 27. \*\*\*PISTOL TYPES ALLOWED\*\*\*: U.S. Service Pistols, along with other pistols currently allowed by CMP Rules (CMP Rule 6.3.4) are authorized. U.S. Pistol, caliber .45, M1911/M1911A1, or U.S. Pistol, 9mm, M9/M9A1. These pistols must be either issued by the U.S. Armed Forces or a commercial pistol of the same type and caliber subject to the specific requirements denoted in CMP Rule 6.6. No scoped pistols will be used during the EIC match. Pistols that exceed their appropriate NRA specifications will be disqualified; scores fired disallowed, and match fees forfeit.
- 28. <u>AMMUNITION:</u> Competitors must supply their own ammunition. Any safe center-fire ammunition, 9mm, (9x10, 9x21mm), .40 S&W, .38 Super, 357 Sig, .400 Cor-Bon, 10mm, 45 G.A.P. or .45 ACP caliber jacketed ammunition may be used. Non-jacketed wad-cutter, lead bullets, tracer, incendiary or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited (Rule 6.6.2 applies).
- 29. **<u>SIGHTS</u>**: Metallic, service (CMP Rule 6.3 applies) sights are allowed. Service pistols using sights other than metallic will not be allowed.
- 30. <u>SCORING SHOTS</u>: Competitor will score each other's targets. Competitors will score in the following manner; Odd number targets will score the target to their right, even number targets will score the target to their left. Place the value of the shot on the other competitor's score card. Challenges will be addressed and confirmed by the competitors at the time of scoring.

## 31. SIGHTER SHOTS: None.

- 32. ALIBIS: Alibis/Re-fires will be in accordance with current CMP pistol rules.
- 33. **EIC AWARDS:** Shooters who finish in the top 10% of those entered will receive points towards the Distinguished Pistol Shot Badge. The CMP will award these points in accordance with the current edition of the CMP Competition Rules Handbook. Official recognition of the Match Winners and the top 10% of competitors will be recorded in the Tournament Results Bulletin.
- 34. **<u>PISTOL INSPECTIONS</u>**. All pistols used in the EIC pistol match must comply with CMP Rules. At the conclusion of each relay, pistols may be selected by random draw for inspection and trigger weighing.

**NOTE:** Upon conclusion of all firing, competitors competing in the pistol EIC and/or .22 pistol EIC Match Aggregate, pistol results will be presented at Range 102.

35. **SCORING SHOTS:** Competitor will score each other's targets. Competitors will score the shooters shots and place the value of the shot on the other Competitor's score card. Challenges will be addressed and confirmed by the competitors at the time of scoring.

## 36. SIGHTER SHOTS: None.

- 37. <u>ALIBIS</u>: Alibis/Re-fires will be in accordance with current CMP Rules.
- 38. **<u>PISTOL INSPECTIONS</u>**: All pistols used in the EIC Pistol Matches must comply with CMP Rules. At the conclusion of each relay, pistols may be selected by random draw for inspection and trigger weighing.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of permitting the applicant for Santa Margarita Gun Club Membership, who is named on the reverse side of this form and herein referred to as THE UNDERSIGNED, to enter the MARINE CORPS BASE CAMP PENDLETON AND SANTA MARGARITA GUN CLUB, herein referred to as the "Santa Margarita Gun Club", premises for the purposes of firearms use, shooting of firearms, observing the shooting of firearms, or any and all other purposes, THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself/herself his/hers heirs, executors, administrators and assigns:

1. Hereby voluntarily releases, discharges, waivers and relinquishes any and all actions or causes of action for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death occurring to the undersigned arising as a result of engaging in or being present at activities at the San Margarita Gun Club premises.

2. Hereby covenants not to sue and voluntarily releases, waivers, discharges and relinquishes any action or causes of action, aforesaid, which may hereafter arise for himself/herself and for his/her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns prosecute or present any claim for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death against MCB, Camp Pendleton, CA, or the Santa Margarita Gun Club or any of its officers, agents, servants or employees for any of said causes of action, whether the same shall arise by negligence of any of said persons or otherwise. IT IS THE INTENTION OF THE UNDERSIGNED BY THIS INSTRUMENT, TO EXEMPT AND RELIEVE THE SANTA MARGARITA GUN CLUB OR ANY OF ITS' OFFICERS, AGENTS, SERVANTS OR EMPLOYEES; INCLUDING VOLUNTEERS, FROM LIABILITY FOR PERSONAL INJURY, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR WRONGFUL DEATH CAUSED BY NEGLIGENCE.

3. Agrees that in the event any claim for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death shall be prosecuted against the Santa Margarita Gun Club.
