- PISTOL RANGE LOCATION: Range 102, Range Complex, Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton

   Start Time: Sunday 0700 hours, and will be held PRIOR TO the Rifle EIC/NMC Match.
- 3. <u>**RIFLE RANGE LOCATION:**</u> Range 103, Range Complex's, MCB Camp Pendleton, CA.

### 4. **<u>RIFLE RANGE FACILITIES:</u>**

**Range 103** is a 140-point firing range. Sanitary facilities are of the "Port-a-Potty" variety. There are no food or drink facilities. It is <u>highly recommended that you bring bottled drinks (non-alcoholic)</u> and/or non-perishable food items. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on or in the general vicinity of the firing lines, while live fire is being conducted.

### 5. **<u>RULES:</u>**

Current CMP Rules for the Service Pistol and Rifle EIC Matches will apply.

### 6. COMPETITION OPEN TO - ELIGIBILITY:

These matches are open to all citizens and legal residents of the United States of America. Citizens of foreign nations may enter these matches upon proof of legal entry into the USA (validated passport and/or visa). Membership in the National Rifle Association, Civilian Marksmanship Program or California Rifle & Pistol Association is not required; however, <u>Membership in the Santa Margarita</u> <u>Gun Club is required.</u>

#### <u>Those persons who cannot legally participate in the shooting sports or who cannot enter a federal</u> <u>military reservation are not eligible to participate in this tournament.</u>

Participation **DOES NOT** and **WILL NOT** automatically authorize entrance onto MCB Camp Pendleton, CA.

To ensure authorized entry onto the base, eligible competitors must ensure you do the following:

- > Possess a Department of Defense Vehicle Sticker authorizing you to enter the military instillation **OR**
- > Pre-enter the matches desired utilizing the Electronic Entry forms on the club's web site AND
- ➤ Have in your possession the following items:
  - a. Valid Driver's License and or other picture Identification
  - b. Current Vehicle Registration
  - c. Current Proof of Vehicle Insurance
- > Complete the Electronically Advance Entry into the scheduled Matches.

### 7. <u>**REGISTRATION FEES & TOURNAMENT FEES**</u>:

All competitors are required to be SMGC Members due to USMC range usage agreements and Insurance Restrictions. If you are not an annual SMGC member, an assessment fee is included for the <u>Daily SMGC Membership</u> in the entry fee. Annual SMGC membership must be confirmed through possession of a valid membership card, or confirmation of participant inclusion in the official membership roster at the morning of registration. SMGC Membership is open to all Active Duty Members, Reserve Members and Retirees of the United States Armed Forces. Annual Regular SMGC Civilian Memberships are dependent upon the number of Current Military members of the Club, according to the club's By Laws.

### 8. ENTRIES - Electronic: ALL ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED IN ADVANCE:

Advanced Entries must be made BEFORE the <u>Wednesday</u> preceding the actual Match Dates. All Entries AFTER Wednesday 3:00 P.M. (PST) are considered to be <u>LATE</u> and will be subject to <u>\$10.00</u> <u>LATE FEE prior to the start of the match</u>. Individual competitor entries are <u>ALSO REQUIRED</u> to indicate their intent to participate <u>using the electronic Match Registration form</u> available at the SMGC website (<u>www.smgunclub.org</u>). Electronic Entries are necessary to ensure Names are provided to the Base Security Office by the close of business on the Wednesday prior to the event.

9. MCB Camp Pendleton Security Regulations require the match sponsor (SMGC) notify the appropriate Base agency of Non Department of Defense (DOD) persons participation in the Match on the Wednesday preceding the Matches. <u>This notification is generated by the received match entry</u> forms and intention to enter messages. Therefore entry onto MCB Camp Pendleton may be <u>denied</u> to those persons who do not indicate their intent to participate or observe using the electronic Match <u>Registration form</u>. Additionally, persons who have expired driver's licenses will not be granted entry onto Camp Pendleton. Registration match forms must also be completed in their entirety. Failure to complete the information section and NRA Membership Number section of the registration form may lead to the inability to correctly report classification to the NRA.

10. <u>ENTRY FEES</u>: All individual Entries must be paid in prior to the start of the matches. All competitors are required to be SMGC Members due to USMC range usage agreements. If you are not an annual SMGC member, an assessment fee is included for Daily SMGC Membership in the entry fee.

- 11. <u>ENTRIES CLOSE</u>: Individual Entries close on the Wednesday prior to the respective match date(s) at 12:00 P.M. (PST).
- 12. <u>POST ENTRIES:</u> Entries <u>RECEIVED</u> after 12:00 P.M. (PST), Wednesday prior to the respective match date(s) are considered <u>LATE Entries</u> and may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relay only. <u>LATE ENTRIES</u> will be subject to <u>\$ 10.00 LATE FEE prior to the start of the match</u>.
- 13. **ENTRY LIMIT:** 60 Individual Entries for each Match.

- 14. <u>MATCH START TIMES:</u> 8:00 AM on Sunday & CMP Rifle EIC 10:00 AM (approximately) on Sunday.
- 15. CMP EIC Service Pistol "Leg" Match SUNDAY 0800 Hours on Range 102

- 16. **<u>RULES</u>**: Current Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Rules will apply.
- 17. **\*\*\*PISTOL TYPES ALLOWED\*\*\*:** U.S. Service Pistols, along with other Pistols currently allowed by CMP Rules (CMP Rule 6.3.4) are authorized. U.S. Pistol, Caliber .45, M1911/M1911A1, or U.S. Pistol, 9mm, M9/M9A1. These pistols must be either issued by the U.S. Armed Forces or a commercial pistol of the same type and caliber subject to the specific requirements denoted in CMP Rule 6.6. No scoped pistols will be used during the EIC match. Pistols that exceed their appropriate NRA specifications will be disqualified; scores fired disallowed, and match fees forfeit.
- <u>AMMUNITION</u>: Competitors must supply their own ammunition. Any safe center-fire ammunition, 9mm, (9x10, 9x21mm), .40 S&W, .38 Super, 357 Sig, .400 Cor-Bon, 10mm, 45 G.A.P. or .45 ACP caliber jacketed ammunition may be used. Non-Jacketed Wad Cutter, Lead Bullets Tracer, incendiary or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited (Rule 6.6.2 applies).
- 19. <u>SIGHTS:</u> Metallic, Service (CMP Rule 6.3 applies) sights are allowed. Service Pistols using sights other than metallic will not be allowed.
- 20. <u>SCORING SHOTS</u>: Competitor will score each other's targets. Competitors will score in the following manner; Odd number Targets will score the target to their right, Even number Targets will score the target to their left. Place the value of the shot on the other Competitor's score card. Challenges will be addressed and confirmed by the competitors at the time of scoring.

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#### 21. SIGHTER SHOTS: None

- 22. ALIBIS: Alibis/Re-fires will be in accordance with current CMP Outdoor Pistol Rules.
- 23. <u>EIC AWARDS</u>: Shooters who finish in the top 10% of those entered will receive points towards the Distinguished Pistol Shot Badge. The CMP will award these points in accordance with the current edition of the CMP Competition Rules Handbook. Official recognition of the Match Winners and the top 10% of competitors will be recorded in the Tournament Results Bulletin.
- 24. <u>**PISTOL INSPECTIONS:**</u> All Pistols used in the EIC Pistol Match must comply with CMP Rules. At the conclusion of each relay, pistols may be selected by random draw for inspection and trigger weighing. <u>**RULES:**</u> Current Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Rules will apply to those competing in the EIC (Leg) Rifle Match. Current National Rifle Association (NRA) High Power Rifle Rules will apply to those competing in the NMC Rifle Match; with the exception of **NO SIGHTERS** will be allowed.

### 26. RIFLE EIC WEAPONS ALLOWED:

U.S. Rifle, Caliber .30, M1, U.S. Rifle, Caliber .30, M14, or U.S. Rifle, Caliber, 5.56mm, M16. These rifles must be either issued by the U.S. Armed Forces or a commercial rifle of the same type and caliber subject to the specific requirements denoted in CMP Rule 6.2.

- 27. **<u>RIFLE SIGHTS</u>**: Metallic & Optic, Service (Rule 3.1(e) and 3.7 applies) sights are allowed.
- 28. <u>SCORING SHOTS</u>: Competitor will score each other's targets. Competitors will score the shooters shots and place the value of the shot on the other Competitor's score card. Challenges will be addressed and confirmed by the competitors at the time of scoring.

### 29. SIGHTER SHOTS: None

- 30. <u>ALIBIS</u>: Alibis/Re-fires will be in accordance with current CMP Rules.
- 31. <u>CMP EIC AWARDS</u>: Shooters who finish in the top 10% of those entered will receive points towards the Distinguished Pistol Shot Badge. The CMP will award these points in accordance with the current edition of the CMP Competition Rules Handbook. Official recognition of the Match Winners and the top 10% of competitors will be recorded in the Tournament Results Bulletin.

32. **<u>RIFLE INSPECTIONS</u>**: All Rifles used in the EIC Rifle Match must comply with CMP Rules. At the conclusion of each relay, rifles may be selected by random draw for inspection and trigger weighing.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

33. <u>CHECK-IN PROCEDURES:</u> All Pistol and Rifle competitors must check in at the Statistical Office for administrative processing.

<u>CMP Pistol EIC Tournament</u> (Range 102) The Statistical Office will be open from <u>6:30 AM to 7:00</u> <u>AM</u> on <u>Sunday</u> morning.

<u>CMP Rifle EIC Tournament</u> – Check in at (Range 102), on <u>Sunday</u> Morning at <u>9:00 AM</u> at the Pistol EIC Match.

Competitors are required to complete administrative processing, ensure payment of tournament fees, and receive their squadding assignments before they can participate.

### 34. MANDATORY RANGE SAFETY & ENVIRONMENTAL BREIFING:

After completion of administrative processing, report to the designated yard line not later than 7:00 AM (Sat-Pistol Range); 7:00 AM

After the conclusion of the Pistol EIC Tournament, All Rifle EIC competitors must attend the mandated range safety and environmental briefing. Competitors not attending the mandated briefing <u>will not be</u> <u>allowed</u> to compete. Entry fees will be refunded less a \$10.00 processing charge. After the Safety & Environmental Briefing, Competitors will move over to Range 103 for the start of the Rifle EIC competition.

- 35. <u>TARGET PULLERS</u>: Rifle Competitors will be required to pull targets. Target pullers "for hire" <u>maybe</u> available at a cost of \$25.00 per shooter. <u>Paid Target Pullers are not guaranteed.</u> ALL SMGC competitors are expected to take turns performing this service. If unable to perform this task, the shooter must provide a viable puller instead.
- 36. **<u>TARGETS</u>**: Official NRA Targets will be used in the rifle competitions.
- 37. <u>COMPETITOR PARKING AREAS</u>: (*Range 103*) Competitor parking maybe permitted in the designated parking lot at the 600 yard line and along the shoulder of Stage Coach Road. The normal Competitor parking area at Range 103 adjacent to the east side of the range is under construction and is not available to be used.
- 38. **SAFETY EQUIPMENT:** Hearing Protection, Eye Protection, and Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI) are <u>mandatory</u>. ECI's may be purchased at the range for a cost of \$ 2.00.
- 39. **OTHER EQUIPMENT:** Cloth, canvas or leather shooting jackets may be used. Standard militaryissue web or leather slings or slings of this same type are permitted. Shooting gloves or mitts, ground cloths or shooting mats may be used. Shooting kits may be placed on the firing line provided they are not forward of the competitor or the firing line and do not interfere with other competitors.

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- 40. **<u>RIFLE TYPES ALLOWED</u>**: CMP Service Rifle (Rule 3.1(e) and 3.7 applies). Rifles that exceed their appropriate specifications will be disqualified; scores fired disallowed, and match fees forfeit.
- 41. <u>AMMUNITION</u>: Competitors must supply their own ammunition. Any safe center-fire ammunition, up to and including 7.62mm (.308 caliber), may be used. No .30-06 ammunition is allowed on Range 103 due to USMC SDZ requirements. **Tracer, incendiary or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited** (Rule 3.17(b) applies).
- 42. <u>SIGHTING SHOTS</u>: NO Sighting shots are allowed for this tournament. Refer to the Courses of Fire section.
- 43. <u>SCORING SHOTS</u>: Competitor will score each other's targets. Competitors will score the shooters shots and place the value of the shot on the other Competitor's score card. Challenges will be addressed and confirmed by the competitors at the time of scoring.
- 44. <u>CHALLENGES</u>: A fee of \$2.00 is required and payable upon requesting the challenge. If the challenge is denied, the fee will be forfeit.
- 45. <u>CHALLENGE PERIOD</u>: The challenge period will end ½ hour after the posting of the last match results.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of permitting the applicant for Santa Margarita Gun Club Membership, who is named on the reverse side of this form and herein referred to as THE UNDERSIGNED, to enter the MARINE CORPS BASE CAMP PENDLETON AND SANTA MARGARITA GUN CLUB, herein referred to as the "Santa Margarita Gun Club", premises for the purposes of firearms use, shooting of firearms, observing the shooting of firearms, or any and all other purposes, THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself/herself his/hers heirs, executors, administrators and assigns:

1. Hereby voluntarily releases, discharges, waivers and relinquishes any and all actions or causes of action for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death occurring to the undersigned arising as a result of engaging in or being present at activities at the San Margarita Gun Club premises.

2. Hereby covenants not to sue and voluntarily releases, waivers, discharges and relinquishes any action or causes of action, aforesaid, which may hereafter arise for himself/herself and for his/her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns prosecute or present any claim for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death against MCB, Camp Pendleton, CA, or the Santa Margarita Gun Club or any of its officers, agents, servants or employees for any of said causes of action, whether the same shall arise by negligence of any of said persons or otherwise. IT IS THE INTENTION OF THE UNDERSIGNED BY THIS INSTRUMENT, TO EXEMPT AND RELIEVE THE SANTA MARGARITA GUN CLUB OR ANY OF ITS' OFFICERS, AGENTS, SERVANTS OR EMPLOYEES; INCLUDING VOLUNTEERS, FROM LIABILITY FOR PERSONAL INJURY, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR WRONGFUL DEATH CAUSED BY NEGLIGENCE.

3. Agrees that in the event any claim for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death shall be prosecuted against the Santa Margarita Gun Club. 4. Agrees that the foregoing release is intended to be as broad and inclusive a permitted by the laws applicable in the State of California and that of any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

Acknowledges that the Undersigned has been fully and completely advised of the potential for serious accident incidental to engaging in firearms activities, including the potential for death, personal injury and property damage, and expressly agrees to assume all risks of loss, damage or injury that may be sustained by the Undersigned.

6. This agreement supersedes all previous agreements and shall remain in force until January 31, 2020.
